Ickford Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

Information Statement

Referendum: Thursday 6th May 2021

A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Ickford Neighbourhood Plan 2019 – 2033 on Thursday 6 May 2021.

The question which will be asked in the Referendum is:

'Do you want Buckinghamshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Ickford to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

The referendum area and the neighbourhood plan area covers the same area as the parish of Ickford (see map below).

Can I Vote?

- You can vote in the referendum if you live in the parish of Ickford and;
- You are registered to vote in local council elections, and
- You are 18 years of age or over on Thursday 6th May 2021
- You have to be registered to vote by 19 April 2021 to vote in the referendum. You can check if you are registered to vote by calling 01296 798141 or emailing elections@buckinghamshire.gov.uk

The expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2,362 + (559 x £0.059) = £2,394.98

The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 559.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government elections.


