

# Wendover Neighbourhood Plan Examination - Procedural Questions

## AVDC Answers to Procedural Questions:

In response to the Independent Examiner's procedural letter and questions dated 28/08/2019 AVDC have the following replies:

1. AVDC have considered the submission documents and representations received against the European Convention on Human Rights and have found nothing that would indicate any breach of the Convention. Whilst no equalities impact assessment has been undertaken the Neighbourhood Plan would appear to have neutral or positive impacts on groups with protected characteristics, for example through policies supporting accessible housing.
2. The Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP) is in the latter stages of examination, having received the Examiner's interim findings including which main modifications are required to be made in order for the VALP to be found sound. AVDC expects to consult on these main modifications in October 2019, following which the Examiner will issue their final binding report and the VALP can be adopted by AVDC, expected at about Christmas time. The Council has published all our suggested modifications to the Submission VALP on our website for transparency (available [here](#)) however these may change slightly before AVDC undertake the formal consultation on the main modifications. Given the late stage of the VALP we consider the NP should be in general conformity with it to ensure the NP remains up to date and effective as a land use plan following VALP's adoption.

AVDC would also be happy to provide comments, where appropriate, on any of the other matters raised to the NPG if this would be of use to the Examiner.
