1. Introduction

2. Background

Aylesbury Vale District Council are responsible for our off-street car parks.

Buckinghamshire County Council have been responsible for on-street parking since 22 March 2012 and merged all of the districts to be enforced by an external agency.

AVDC are responsible for the operation of 11 car parks in Aylesbury, 3 in Buckingham, 1 in Wendover and 2 in Winslow, comprising of a total of 3012 spaces. The car parks are operated under the legislation set out in the Traffic Management Act 2004.
