PROGRESS WITH IMPLEMENTATION OF THE LOCAL DEVELOPMENT SCHEME

The Council is required to produce monitoring reports that contain information regarding the implementation of the Local Development Scheme (LDS).

The LDS for Aylesbury Vale was published in November 2013¹. This was an update to the previous LDS of April 2013. The LDS sets out the timetable that the Council will follow for the period 2011 to 2015.

Two milestones within the LDS fall within 2013. Both these milestones were met:

- Publication of the Vale of Aylesbury Plan Strategy in spring 2013 followed by submission in summer 2013. The publication period ran between 8th May until 19th June 2013 and the plan was submitted to government for independent examination on 12th August 2013.
- Examination hearings, which were originally scheduled for autumn 2013 in the April 2013 LDS but updated in the November 2013 LDS to Winter 2013/early 2014. The examination has been split into two stages with the first sessions on Duty to Cooperate and the levels of housing and employment growth having taken place on the 10th, 12th and 13th December. There are a further two weeks scheduled to commence 17th and 24th February if the inspector is satisfied on the issues raised in the first sessions.
- Consultation on the Vale of Aylesbury Plan Delivery in late 2013/Spring 2014. An initial consultation took place between 29th August and 10th October 2013.

We have also:

- Published a number of documents alongside the publication of the Vale of Aylesbury Plan Strategy including a series of topic papers, a Consultation Statement, Updated Demographic Projections Report April 2013 and May 2013, Strategic Housing Market Assessment 2013, Supplementary Report to the Strategic Housing Market Assessment 2013, Strategic Housing Land Availability Assessment 2013, Settlement Hierarchy 2013 and Sustainability Appraisal Supplementary Evidence 2013.
- Published a Gypsy and Traveller and Travelling showpeople Accommodation Needs Assessment jointly with Wycombe, Chiltern and South Bucks District Councils.
