NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT ORDERS AND NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLANS

The Localism Act contains provisions for communities (normally parish or town councils) to prepare neighbourhood development plans, neighbourhood development orders and community right to build orders. A number of parish/town councils in Aylesbury Vale have begun the process of preparing neighbourhood development plans and the first neighbourhood plan in the district has now been formally 'made', as detailed below:

Winslow Town Council	Neighbourhood Area approved February 2013. Pre Submission Consultation completed 12 August- 5 October 2013. The plan was submitted to AVDC early December 2013 with publicity consultation taking place between 4 December 2013 and 22 January 2014. An independent examiners found the plan met the basic conditions in May 2014. A referendum was held on 24 July 2014 with 98% voting in favour of the plan. Following the successful referendum the plan was formally 'made' on 10 September 2014 and now forms part of the development plan.
Buckingham Town Council	Further revised Neighbourhood Area boundary approved November 2014.
Haddenham Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in July 2013. Pre Submission Consultation running 6 December 2014 until 20 January 2015.
Marsh Gibbon Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in February 2013. The plan was submitted to AVDC in June 2014 with publicity consultation taking place between 1 July 2014 and 26 August 2014. An independent examiners found the plan met the basic conditions in September 2014. A referendum was held on 11 December 2014 with 93% voting in favour of the plan.
Wing Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in September 2012. The plan was submitted to AVDC in September 2014 with publicity consultation taking place between 24 October 2014 and 5 December 2014.
Wingrave-with-Rowsham Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in September 2012.
Great Horwood Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in September 2012. The plan was submitted to AVDC in July 2014 with publicity consultation taking place between 21 July 2014 and 8 September 2014. A examination hearing day was held on 27 November 2014.
Quainton Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in September 2012.
Cheddington Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in October 2013.
Chilton parish	Neighbourhood Area approved in February 2014.

Buckland Parish Council	Neighbourhood Area approved in January 2014.
Newton Longville	Neighbourhood Area approved in September 2014.
Pitstone	Neighbourhood Area approved in November 2014.
Ivinghoe	Neighbourhood Area submitted, consultation ran until 17 December.
Slapton	Neighbourhood Area submitted, consultation ran until 17 December.

In addition, Dinton with Ford and Upton Parish Council had a Neighbourhood Area approved in December 2012 but the Parish Council have since decided not to prepare a neighbourhood plan.
