Ref: Application for designation of neighbourhood area for Worminghall Parish Council (WPC)

I am writing on behalf of WPC as its Chair to apply for the designation of the parish of Worminghall as a neighbourhood area under regulation 5 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 as the parish council intends to develop a neighbourhood plan for the parish.

Regulation 5 (1) requires an area application to include

- (a) A map of the area in question
- (b) A statement explaining why the area is considered appropriate to be designated (see below)
- (c) A statement that the body making the application is the relevant body for the purposes of Section 61 G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, as amended by Schedule 9 to the Localism Act 2011.

1. WPC operates within the Worminghall parish boundaries shown on the attached map. The application relates to the whole of the parish and is considered as being appropriate to be designated as the Worminghall Parish Neighbourhood Area.
2. WPC resolved at its meeting on 26 May 2016 to establish a neighbourhood plan for the parish to ensure its future as a thriving and active community. WPC considers the parish of Worminghall appropriate to be designated as the Neighbourhood Area for Worminghall.
3. Under Section 61F of the 1990 Act a parish council is authorised to act in relation to a neighbourhood area if that area consists of or includes the whole or part of any area of the council. We confirm that WPC is a constituted parish council which makes this council the relevant body to act on behalf of the parish in this context.

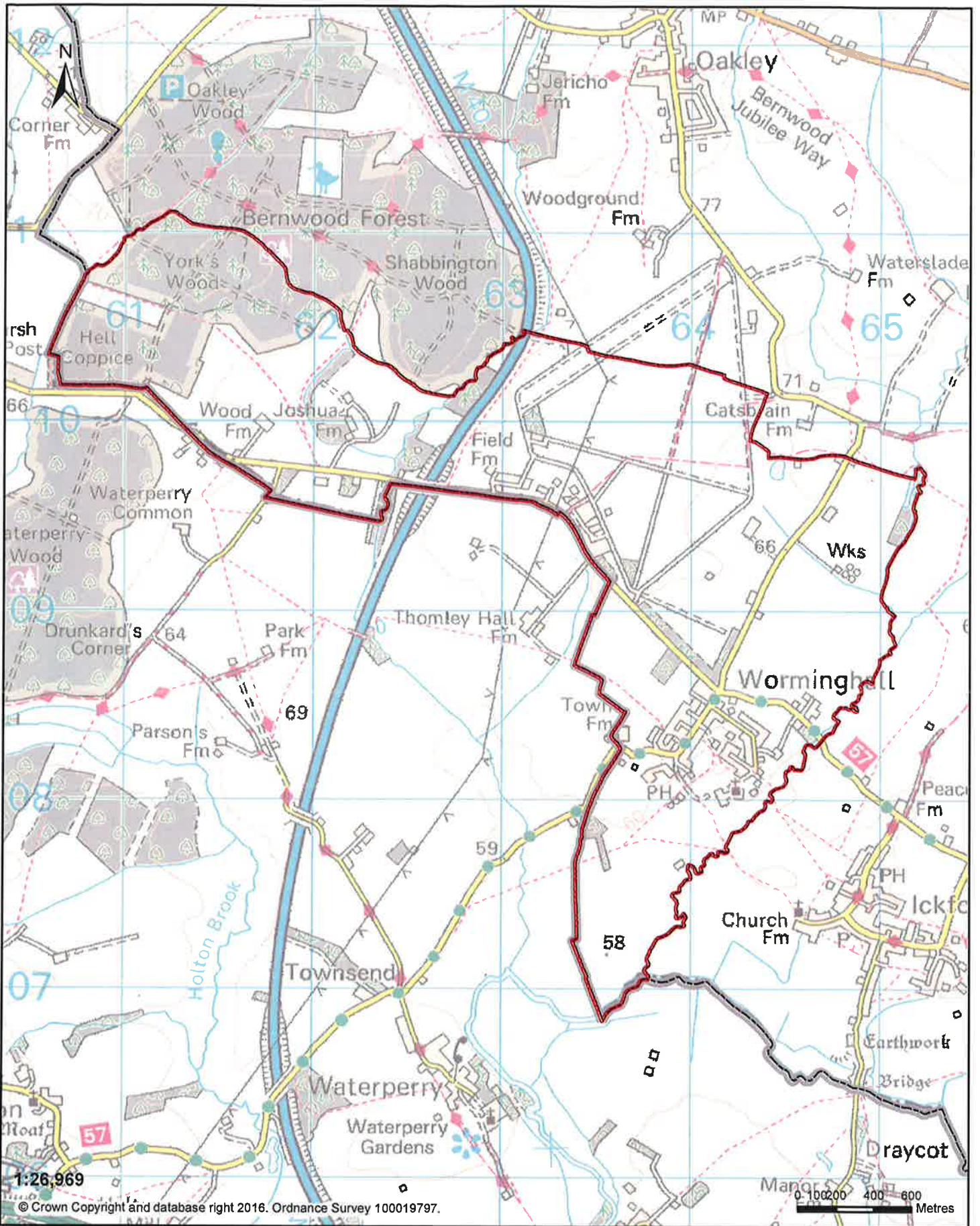
