## STATEMENT OF CONSULTATION

- i) The public consultation period ran from 13<sup>th</sup> September 2004 to 25<sup>th</sup> October 2004. A public notice advertising the consultation appeared in the Bucks Herald, Bucks Advertiser and Thame Gazette. During the public consultation period, the draft Planning Brief was publicised in Haddenham Library, in the Council's Customer Service Centre, on the Haddenham village website, and on the Council's website.
- ii) Posters advertising the consultation were placed in various public locations around Haddenham village.
- iii) A public exhibition was held at the Scout and Guide Centre, Banks Park, Haddenham on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September (2pm-7pm) and Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> September (10am-4pm)
- iv) Various groups and individuals were sent copies of the draft Planning Brief and were asked for comment. These included: local Parish Councils, adjacent District and County Councils, Heads of Service at AVDC, statutory consultees, economic and environmental organisations, local community groups.
- v) 34 representations were received.
- vi) The Council's response to these representations was approved and the Planning Brief (amended accordingly) was approved on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2005.
