



GUIDANCE FOR MAKING AN APPLICATION

Re: Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976

The following is information required by Aylesbury Vale District Council to enable them to process your licence application.

Your application should be completed and signed together with appropriate details of where and how the Animals are to be kept, together with the fee [see current fees list]. You must also provide evidence of public liability insurance with the application.

In addition to the information requested on the application form, could you provide details of your qualifications and experience of keeping such animals and the specific security arrangements you propose to have in place.

Before a licence can be granted the premises where the animals will be kept must be inspected and approved by an authorised veterinary surgeon and officers from this authority. All licences expire on 31st December each year, therefore inspections will take place annually.
